- Developed collaborations and other outreach
- Efforts to assure high visibility
- Applicability of initiatives to a broader audience
- Planning for ongoing initiatives

The selected recipient will be honored at the spring recognition program. Recipient will receive a \$500 award which can be used at the educational institute or school of her choice and will be nominated for the AAUW of Oregon Breaking Barriers Achievement Award.

- 2. A brief biography describing her achievements
- 3. Nominating person and contact information
